

Why now?


- Many years, significant increases in Portal use, and many new website and mapping requirements since the last complete overhaul and redesign in 2017
- Upgrade user mapping and visualization tools and enhance connections to core external data providers
- Improve integration of Portal webpages and contextual information with map interfaces and data products
- Increase the ability for users to view select data products at multiple geographic scales
- Provide ability for place-based or specific management focused tools and analyses



Why now?

Timeline

- Started scoping in 2023
- Implement first big updates in 2024
- Continue to scope and implement additional tools and functions in 2025 and later


Northeast Canyons and Seamounts

On September 12, 2023, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) jointly released a Draft Management Plan and Environmental Assessment for the Northeast Canyons and Seamounts Marine National Monument for public review and comment. Figures 12-18 in the Draft Management Plan and Environmental Assessment are Northeast Ocean Data Portal maps with relevant data on marine life and ocean uses.

To support the public comment process, this Map Gallery provides interactive versions of Figures 12-18. 
Renewable Energy Leases map layer (colored blocks) and NEFSC data on fall and spring Atlantic cod biomass from 2010-2019

 - Enhanced layer searchability
 - More options for organizing and/or filtering the Data Explorer Table of Contents
 - Better data catalog
 - Streamlined Portal maintenance




Scope of the 2024 work

"Front end" / User Experience

- Data Download
 - Better integration with Data Explorer and other maps
 - Single layer/topic downloads instead of theme packages
 - FUTURE: Data Download for an area of interest or active map view

- Current issues better integration with map pages and relevant datasets
- Review of Theme Maps
- Redesigned and simplified homepage




Scope of the 2024 work


"Front end" / User Experience

Add/Improve Data Explorer Tools

- Compare maps of different data/at different scales (swipe, composite)
- Standardize time/animation tools
- Scope standardizing widgets (marine life, communities at sea)
- Improve share link functionality and more customizations (e.g., include basemap or not)
- FUTURE: subset and summarize data by area of interest
